

Equity at ClarkMUN

At ClarkMUN, we want to ensure that all of our spaces are safe, equitable and comfortable for all delegates, faculty advisors and staffers. A resource ClarkMUN provides for any equity related issues is our general equity issue form. In this form, delegates, faculty, and staffers are able to report any type of inappropriate behavior. The form will be constantly monitored by the Chief of Staff throughout the day, and they will be in contact with those individuals whom wish to not remain anonymous on their submission. Event Procedures

Registration: All delegations must register before entering any Clark University spaces designated for ClarkMUN related events. Delegates who are not wearing their name tags will not be allowed in committee rooms and at the cafeteria. Registration will happen from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM at Atwood Hall, located in 150 Woodland St. Delegates can be dropped off at this address. Once delegations enter Atwood Hall, there will be a lobby where Secretariat members will be delivering name tags, placards, and instructions for the day.

Opening Ceremonies: Opening Ceremonies will take place from 9:00 AM to 9:30 AM at Atwood Hall Theater (Daniel's Theater). All delegations must be seated by 9:00 AM to start promptly. The Opening Ceremonies will include a series of statements, guest speaker video, and final instructions for the day. Once concluded, each committee will depart to their committee rooms, under the chair's guidance. Please make sure to pay attention to when your committee is called.

Committee Sessions: Committees will take place in the following buildings: Jonas Clark, Sackler, Jefferson Academic Center, and Atwood Hall. Please see committee room roster above for more information. All delegates must be in their committee rooms by 9:40 AM.



Lunch: Lunch will be taking place at Harvest Table at Higgins, located at Higgins University Center (building next to Sackler). Chairs will be walking with delegates to the dining hall/cafeteria. Lunch is provided as part of your delegate fee. Lunch times vary per committee bloc. For reference, look at page 5 to find more information about your lunch bloc. This is to prevent traffic at Harvest Table and make it an enjoyable experience. Should a delegate want to purchase lunch outside of campus, they must contact their Faculty Advisor and visit the restaurant of their choice alongside their Faculty Advisor.

Closing Ceremonies: Closing ceremonies will initiate at 4:45 PM at Atwood Hall Theater (Daniel's Theater). Please make sure to be seated by that time. Closing Ceremonies will consist of final statements and awards ceremony, in which we will recognize our committees' top performers. Once the ceremonies are concluded, Secretariat will remain at Atwood Hall for 30 more minutes to answer any last minute questions regarding ClarkMUN or awards. After this time, schools are free to leave our campus.



Committee Formats

SPECPOL: This committee will be run as a double-delegation. Two delegates will represent the same country and act as a "team". There will be designated times where 1 delegate will be "in-room" (doing speeches, making motions, etc.), while the other delegate is "out-room" (forming a bloc, writing resolutions, etc.) Please contact the Chair directly for more detailed information.

UNHRC and VOC: These committees will operate as regular GAs.

Committee to Protect Journalists This committee will run as a regular GA, with the addition of writing a press release (in addition to the draft resolution). For more information, contact the Chair.

Elden Ring, Salem Crisis, and Indonesian Democracy/Demokrasi Sekarang: These committees will operate as regular crisis committees, with full-crisis elements (backroom with crisis notes and in-room directives). A two notepad system will be utilized for these committees. Notepads will be provided.

JCC Clark Students v. Admin: Our joint crisis committee will work as 2 separate crisis committees, but the course of action of each committee will have repercussions on the other "side" – meaning, if JCC Students passes a directive affecting JCC Admin, JCC Admin's update will be strictly related to the JCC Students' actions.
